

MCLGA SUPPORTS READY GOLF IN STROKEPLAY COMPETITIONS

- Hole 1, tee off in order of the draw. For remaining holes, if you're ready first, play first.
- 2. Mark the scorecard on the next tee after you have teed off unless you're last to play.
- Play your shot before helping someone to look for a lost ball (3 minutes maximum).
- When not playing your shot, you should be preparing your shot getting ready to play.
- 5. Shorter hitters play first from tee or fairway if longer hitters are having to wait.
- 6. Play your shot if a person is furthest from the hole with a challenging shot and assessing their options from any area including a penalty area.
- 7. Play your shot if a person who has just played from a bunker and is still furthest from the hole but is delayed due to raking the bunker.
- 8. Play your shot to the green if another player has played through the back and has not yet reached their ball.
- 9. Putt out if your ball is close to the hole, even if it means standing close to a player's line, but not on it.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

- If in doubt, play a provisional.
- Leave your equipment in direction of travel from green to tee.
- Keep up with the game in front. Lose a hole...... then invite the game behind through.
- Recommended 40 seconds for players to play their shot.
- ALWAYS Rake bunkers, Replace Divots and Repair Pitch marks.
