



MIDLOTHIAN COUNTY LADIES' GOLF ASSOCIATION
GREENSOMES MATCHES
TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. All categories of membership within MCLGA are eligible to play in their club's Greensomes teams. The Greensomes recorder greensomes@mclga.com who should be a member of MCLGA will be appointed biennially.

2. Greensomes matches are competitive and inclusive, open to all Midlothian players who wish to represent their clubs with the emphasis on participation. Players compete in pairs with handicap allocations hopefully ensuring as level a playing field as possible. A player who is a member of more than one Club in MCLGA may play in the Greensomes for one Club and in the 5 a-side matches for another Club. Players who have played or may play in the Club's 5 a side team for that year may play in the Greensomes but priority should be given to those who are unlikely to do so.

3. A member can only play for one club in the Greensomes matches. Any member who is a member of more than one participating club must choose which Club they will play for by 31st March.

4. Clubs may have one or two participating teams. Any club, which has not previously participated, wishing to enter a team or any club which wishes to enter a second team or any club which has had two teams playing but wishes to reduce to one must advise the Greensomes recorder greensomes@mclga.com or any office bearer accordingly by the first Friday in October of the year prior to the competition starting.

5. Where a club has two participating teams each team shall play in a different Section and the Club's Greensomes representative should draw up lists of their two separate squads and intimate them to the Greensomes recorder greensomes@mclga.com by 1 April. If additional players are to be added to those squads during the year the representative should advise the recorder greensomes@mclga.com accordingly. In the event that a team cannot be raised from one of the separate squads, in exceptional circumstances and as a last resort, players from the other squad may be used but only on two occasions each season. Rule 15 below would thereafter apply.

6. The matches will be played in two independent Sections: A and B. At the end of the season two teams from Section B will move across to Section A and vice versa. Taking account of separating teams from the same club it will be the highest two in Section B and the lowest two in Section A. Where there is an odd number of teams in each Section, three teams will move from the bigger Section and two from the smaller to allow each Section to have an equivalent number of games over a two year period. Match organisers will attempt to exchange venues i.e. home & away for those teams who are playing each other in two consecutive years.

7. Matches are to be played Monday to Friday before 2.30pm. Dates and starting times of all matches are to be sent to greensomes@mclga.com by the end of January each year. All matches should be completed by the middle of September.

8. Greensomes handicap calculated for each pair (i.e. 0.6 of the lower handicap + 0.4 of the higher handicap) and strokes to be given are the full difference of Greensomes Handicaps. This allowance should not be rounded, but should be expressed as an exact allowance. The difference between these two exact allowances is calculated, and only then is rounding applied to the exact difference. In other words, rounding takes place only once.

For example:

Pair A (Handicaps 15 and 28) H/cap $0.6 \times 15 = 9.0$ and H/cap $0.4 \times 28 = 11.2$

Added together gives an exact allowance of 20.2

Pair B (Handicaps 16 and 22) H/cap $16 \times 0.6 = 9.6$ H/cap $22 \times 0.4 = 8.8$ Added together gives an exact allowance of 18.4

The difference in exact handicaps between the Pair A & Pair B is 1.8 therefore 1.8 rounded gives a difference of 2

Pair A receives 2 strokes.

9. Matches are to be played in Greensomes handicap order and team cards to be exchanged between Team Captains (of the day) before play commences. Once pairs have been decided and combined handicaps calculated, couples will play in order of the lowest combined handicap first. Where possible it is suggested that pairings should consist of a low handicap player with a higher handicap player, although it is recognised that this is not always possible.

10. Each match will consist of 3 Greensomes games (3 pairs), a game point (1) being awarded to the winner of each Game and half a point (1/2) being awarded to each team when a Game finishes all square after 18 holes.

11. The match will be won by the team with the most Game Points as described in Rule 9 above. The winning team will be awarded two (2) Match Points; the losing team will not receive any Match Points. In the case of a halved match, both teams will be awarded one (1) Match Point.

12. The results card is a downloadable form from the mclga.com web site. The result should be sent to the Recorder (greensomes@mclga.com) within 48 hours of the match.

13. Any cancellations and rearranged games must be notified to the recorder (greensomes@mclga.com).

14. The winner of each Section will be the team with the most match points. If, after calculating match points, a tie occurs for either Section, or if match points cannot decide on the teams to be moved between the Sections, then total game points will count. If a tie still occurs after considering total game points, the trophy winner and Club movement between Sections will be calculated using the holes remaining to be played across all matches. The team with the greater amount of holes to be played will finish above the team with which they were previously tied. If a tie still occurs after considering total holes remaining to be played then the **head to head** match score between the two teams will count, followed by the head to head game points, followed by the head to head total holes remaining to be played.

15. If a club is unable to raise a team on the pre-arranged date, where possible, an alternative date should be found and failing that, matches could be played with two instead of three games, the third game being conceded 5 & 4. Non - MCLGA players could be brought in to make up the third game but the score would still be recorded as 5 & 4.

16. Clubs are not required to provide any catering at these matches. However, it is noted some Clubs provide for their male senior matches and hence provision is given to the ladies Greensomes matches. Providing food at these matches is solely at the Clubs discretion.
