### SUMMER MEETING - GLENCORSE GOLF CLUB

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Glencorse GC for the Summer Meeting.

**All covid rules and restrictions have been lifted in Scotland, but the virus has not gone away.**

We would like to advise competitors of some information prior to attending the Summer Meeting at Glencorse GC. Information has been categorised for ease of reading.

Please ensure you have read the [MCLGA Terms of Competition](#) before attending on the day.

Please note all queries regarding the competition, including tee times, either before or on the day of the competition, are directed to [secretary@mclga.com](mailto:secretary@mclga.com) or the officials on site on the day and not to the Glencorse Professional.

#### **PARKING**

- Please car share if possible as parking is limited.
- There is an overspill car park which is 1st right past the clubhouse and then 1st right again.

#### **BAR & CATERING**

- The Clubhouse will be open from 08:00 until the competition closes.
- The kitchen will be open at 08:30 for breakfast rolls and coffee etc.
- Food will be available all day until 19:00

#### **CHECK-IN**

- **Check in will be in the Clubhouse lounge.**
- Check-in will be to confirm attendance, collect scorecard, and to participate in the optional 2s, sweep and raffle.
- We will be using **ClubV1** and **HowDidIDo** to run the competition and your details will already have been entered into the system. There is nothing to do on the touch screen before playing.
- Your scorecard will have a label on with the necessary information (Date, Competition name Your name, WHI, Playing Handicap, Course Handicap).
- Please exchange cards with your playing partners and complete your playing partner's score and your own at each hole.

#### **FEMALE LOCKER ROOM**

- The female locker room is on the first floor.

## OPTIONAL TWOS, COMPETITION SWEEP & RAFFLE

- A Twos sweep, competition sweep, and a raffle will be in operation for the Spring Meeting. Participation in each shall be optional. Each will be £1 and if possible, **please bring exact amounts**. Juniors may participate in the Twos sweep and the Competition sweep.

## LOCAL RULES

- All local rules are on the Glencorse GC scorecard.
- Preferred lies will NOT be in operation unless there are adverse weather conditions.

## PRACTICE FACILITIES

- The practice putting area is beside the clubhouse. Entry to the putting area is from the car park and not from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee.
- There are 2 practice nets behind and to the right of the Professional Shop beyond the buggy parking area.

## STARTING PLAY

- The 1<sup>st</sup> tee will not have a starter and players are asked to tee off on time. The Club Professional will have a copy of the Tee sheet to keep play running smoothly.
- Play will be from the **Red Tees**

## ON COURSE DISTANCE MEASURES??

- There are distance marker posts just off the fairway indicating the following distances in yards to the center of the green.
  - 200yds, 150yds, 100yds
- The pin position on the green is indicated by small flags on the flagsticks as follows:
  - BOTTOM - front
  - MIDDLE – middle
  - TOP - back

## COURSE TOILET

- There are no toilets on the course, but players can easily gain access to the clubhouse when they come up to the 12th tee.

## ADVERSE WEATHER

- In the event of bad weather causing unplayable or dangerous conditions, a klaxon will be sounded to suspend play.
  - **Klaxon codes** – 1 long blast – play suspended. 2 long blasts – play restarted. Repeated long blasts – possible danger. Players advised to leave course immediately.

## SUBMITTING SCORES

- At the end of your round, please ensure you have checked your scores with your playing partners prior to signing your own card. Please also ensure the person who has marked your card has signed in the appropriate place.
- Then you must enter your scores into How Did I Do using the touch screen in the middle hallway of the Clubhouse
- All results will be detailed in a report on the Midlothian website.
