# PLAYERS' COMMMUNICATION NOTICE AUTUMN MEETING BRUNTSFIELD LINKS GOLFING SOCIETY Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Bruntsfield Links GS for our Autumn Meeting.

All covid rules and restrictions have been lifted in Scotland, but the virus has not gone away. Use 'Covid sense' to protect yourself and others.

We would like to advise competitors of some information prior to attending our Autumn Meeting at Bruntsfield Links GS. Information has been categorised for ease of reading.

Please ensure you have read the <u>MCLGA Terms of Competition</u> before attending on the day.

Please note all queries regarding the competition, including tee times, either before or on the day of the competition, are directed to <u>secretary@mclga.com</u> or the officials on site on the day and not to the Bruntsfield Links Professional.

## PARKING

• There is a sizable car park, so there should be ample space but do car share if possible. The overflow goes into Barnton Avenue on the left-hand side – please, as always, be respectful of residents when parking on the street.

## **BAR & CATERING**

- The Clubhouse will be open from 7am 9pm
- Catering will be available from 8am 5pm. The full menu will be available until 5pm and there will be one hot food special available until 8pm.

#### CHECK-IN

- Check in will be in the Clubhouse lounge. Check-in will be to confirm attendance, collect scorecard and for you to indicate intention to participate in the optional 2s, competition sweep and raffle.
- We will be using **ClubV1** to run the competition and your details will already have been entered into the system. You will be checked into the competition on ClubV1 by an official on the registration desk and given your scorecard. If you already use the HowDidIDo App, please follow the instructions at the bottom of this notice which will enable you to enter your scores into the App when you finish your round. For those who do not use HowDidIDo, your scores will be entered by someone on the Registration Desk.
- Prior to play, you must exchange cards with your playing partners, completing your playing partner's score and your own at each hole.

### FEMALE LOCKER ROOM

- There is a small female locker room available.
- There is a ladies shower and towels available in the mezzanine toilet and ladies toilet upstairs opposite the dining room, with a disabled bathroom downstairs near the members lounge.

#### **OPTIONAL TWOS, COMPETITION SWEEP & RAFFLE**

 A Twos sweep, Competition sweep, and a Raffle will be in operation for the Autumn Meeting. Participation in each shall be optional. Each will be £1 and if possible, please bring cash in exact amounts. Juniors may participate in the Twos sweep and the Competition sweep. The raffle will be in aid of the Caddy Fund.

#### LOCAL RULES

- All local rules are on the Bruntsfield Links GS scorecard.
- The environmentally sensitive area to the left of hole 6 is no longer in operation and with respect to a free drop from staked trees, it is for staked trees, not trees with protective wrapping.

#### **PRACTICE FACILITIES**

- There is a complimentary warm up area adjacent to the club house (irons only) the pro shop will issue a slip to get golf balls.
- For those who wish to hit woods, there is the middle practice area which is a 500m walk from the club house (use own balls).
- In addition, there are 2 nets, a short game area and large putting green.

### **STARTING PLAY**

- The 1<sup>st</sup> tee will not have a starter and players are asked to tee off on time. The Club Professional will have a copy of the Tee sheet to keep play running smoothly.
- Play will be from the **Red Ladies Tees**.

#### **ON COURSE DISTANCE MEASURES**

• There are coloured posts on the edge, and disks in the centre, of the fairway indicating the following distances in yards to the centre of the green:

```
○ BLUE = 150
○ WHITE = 200
```

• The flags are coloured as follows:

RED = front
YELLOW = middle
WHITE = back

#### **COURSE TOILET**

- The on-course toilet is conveniently located near the 6th tee, 8th green and 12th tee. Also the clubhouse is a short walk from the 9th green.
- There are water fountains on the course.

# ADVERSE WEATHER

- In the event of bad weather causing unplayable or dangerous conditions, a klaxon will be sounded to suspend play.
  - **Klaxon codes** 1 long blast play suspended. 2 long blasts play restarted. Repeated long blasts possible danger. Players advised to leave course immediately.

# SUBMITTING SCORES

- At the end of your round, please ensure you have checked your scores with your playing partner prior to signing your own card. Please also ensure the person who has marked your card has signed in the appropriate place.
- Scores are to be submitted in one of 2 ways:
  - For those who already have the HowDidIDo App on their phone, please follow the instructions below to set up MCLGA as your away club. When you come into the clubhouse you should be able to enter your own score. Assistance will be available to those who need help. Your scorecard must then be handed to the official on the registration desk.
  - For those who DO NOT have the HowDidIDo App, your scores will be entered by someone on the registration desk.
- All results will be detailed in a report on the Midlothian website.

# Instructions for adding MCLGA as your Away Club on the HDID App

Please follow these instructions at home before coming to Bruntsfield Links.

When you have completed your round, you will be able to enter your own scores which will help the competition committee immensely in what will be a very busy day.

If you have any problems, **please don't contact the secretary** as we can enter your scores for you on the day.

Step 1: Open the App and Click on the little person's head at the top to Access your Account.

Step 2: Scroll all the way to the bottom and Click on the button "+Add Away Club".

Step 3: Click on M in the alphabetical list of clubs.

Step 4: Choose MCLGA (careful not to select the 2<sup>nd</sup> one down - MLCGA!)

Step 5: Your name should appear, touch the screen to select your name and Press Submit

Step 6 – MCLGA should then appear as your Away club, and you will be able to submit scores (instructions will be available on the day of the competition)
