### BIENNIAL 9 HOLE - RAVELSTON GOLF CLUB

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Ravelston GC for the Biennial 9 Hole.

**All covid rules and restrictions have been lifted in Scotland, but the virus has not gone away.**

We would like to advise competitors of some information prior to attending the Biennial 9 Hole at Ravelston GC. Information has been categorised for ease of reading.

Please ensure you have read the [MCLGA Terms of Competition](#) before attending on the day.

Please note all queries regarding the competition, including tee times, either before or on the day of the competition, are directed to [secretary@mclga.com](mailto:secretary@mclga.com) or the officials on site on the day and not to the Ravelston staff.

#### **PARKING**

- Please car share if possible as parking is limited.
- Overflow parking would be on Ravelston Dykes Road, past the golf club towards Craigcrook Road.

#### **CLUBHOUSE & CATERING**

- The Clubhouse will be open from 08:30 until the competition closes.
- Catering starts at 09:30 for bacon rolls, tea/coffee etc.

#### **CHECK-IN**

- **Check in will be at front of Clubhouse.**
- Check-in will be to confirm attendance, collect scorecard, and to participate in the optional 2s.
- We will be using **ClubV1** and **HowDidIDo** to run the competition and your details will already have been entered into the system. There is nothing to do on the touch screen before playing.
- Your scorecard will have a label on with the necessary information (Date, Competition name, Your name, WHI, Playing Handicap, Course Handicap).
- Please exchange cards with your playing partners and complete your playing partner's score and your own at each hole (Gross score at each hole – system will calculate the Stableford points).

#### **OPTIONAL TWOS**

- A Twos sweep will be in operation for the Biennial 9 Hole. Participation shall be optional. This will be £1 and if possible, **please bring change.**

#### **LOCAL RULES**

- All local rules are on the Ravelston GC scorecard.

- Preferred lies will NOT be in operation unless there are adverse weather conditions.

### **PRACTICE FACILITIES**

- There are practice nets and a practice putting area beside the clubhouse.

### **STARTING PLAY**

- The 1<sup>st</sup> tee will not have a starter and players are asked to tee off on time.
- Play will be from the **Red Tees**
- There are Bells on the 1st and 8th holes to indicate safe to play. Also there are steps at 9th to see the green is clear.
- This is a Stableford competition therefore if you cannot score you can pick up your ball. (Record zero on the card for the hole).

### **ON COURSE DISTANCE MEASURES**

- There are white markers on the fairways and Scots Pines just off the fairways indicating 130 yards to the centre of the greens.

### **ADVERSE WEATHER**

- In the event of bad weather causing unplayable or dangerous conditions, a klaxon will be sounded to suspend play.
  - **Klaxon codes** – 1 long blast – play suspended. 2 long blasts – play restarted. Repeated long blasts – possible danger. Players advised to leave course immediately.

### **SUBMITTING SCORES**

- At the end of your round, please ensure you have checked your scores with your playing partners prior to signing your own card. Please also ensure the person who has marked your card has signed in the appropriate place.
- Then you must enter your scores into How Did I Do using the touch screen on the left of the Clubhouse. There will also be a leaderboard showing.
- All results will be detailed in a report on the Midlothian website.
